4. The Council may consider allowing works-in-lieu to be undertaken provided they are not on the public road, and that they are agreed and approved in advance with the Area Engineer.

The Council undertakes to use its best endeavours to hold confidential, any information provided by you in this application form subject to the Council's obligations under law, including the Freedom of Information Act (as amended). Should you wish that any of the information supplied by you in this application should not be disclosed, because of its sensitivity, you should, when providing the information, identify same and specify the reasons for its sensitivity.
